Summary



- Scenario 6 has been formulated by the team as a result of the feedback received from the clubs meeting
- There are currently 263 fixtures that were postponed prior to the covid shutdown. These fixtures will be pushed to remaining catch up rounds and may have to be scheduled midweek
- To be able to complete the full home/away season for promotion/relegation purposes juniors need to play into early October, given the number of games that need to be completed
- Some competitions that are splitting will still have to play midweek fixtures regardless of the current suggested format
- There are 1946 fixtures that need to be scheduled from the covid shutdown
- Due to there being 2209 fixtures that need to be arranged for season proper, no further postponements can be considered
- In the event of wet weather for the remainder of the season, fixtures will be automatically rescheduled by the metro comps team and communicated by 5pm, the following Tuesday, unless both clubs agree to enter a 0-0 result
- Clubs are encouraged to arrange MiniRoos carnivals as normal if a consideration
- Midweek rounds were scheduled for some BYPL and Division 1 competitions earlier in the season. This caused a lot of disruption for clubs for 11 competitions, this would be dramatically increased as an issue for 65 competitions
- Preliminary Finals have been removed for Capital and Premier League competitions
- Capital, Premier, City, 18's, 20's competitions may finish earlier if clubs choose to forego finals
- MiniRoos may be extended past September 18 if clubs choose to do so, but would remove clubs' ability to host their own carnivals
- Carnivals may be impacted if the government imposes a patron limit on venues
- For the integrity of the full home and away season to be maintained, the rules of each match must remain the same; this is to avoid scenarios where interchange would benefit teams more than others.
